The Factory: El Credito. USA-Miami/FL

One of the leading tobacco factories in Little Havana, El Credito Cigars is a must-stop for cigar fans and those simply fascinated by the art of cigar making. Blink along your walk of Calle Ocho and you might miss the sign in the window that reads "Established in Havana, Cuba, in 1907." The outside may not impress but its authenticity will. A family-owned business, El Credito employs master tobacco rollers, most of whom learned the ancient craft in their Cuban homeland. You won't see any assembly lines here. Instead you'll be able to watch meticulous craftsmen each working individually on creating a fine cigar from scratch. Although they produce a variety of top-quality cigars, their most popular -- and distinguished -- brand is La Gloria Cubana; the Wavell cigar from this brand is highly recommended.
